I felt privileged to be a guest at such a momentous occasion especially as so many of your guests names were present or well represented by family & friends.

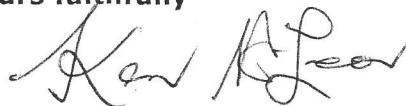
Having played against or been involved in administration with many of the recipients was very moving to myself.
