During the year 1909, Port Pirie was in the throes of an industrial conflict between the management of the B.H.P. and employees.

With the Smelters closed down the outlook of football was not bright.

To carry on a Church Association was formed and so
St. Marks Football Club was born.

St Marks as a club was part and parcel of the Port Pirie Football Association until 1941 when it reverted to the name of Port Football Club.

During that time it played a very important part in Port Pirie Football history and continues to do so under the club Green and White.
